SUBJECT: Street Lighting – Schedule SL

AVAILABILITY

To all municipalities and political subdivisions for street lighting service with the condition that said municipalities, etc. become members of the Cooperative.

HOURS OF SERVICE

Dusk to dawn controlled by photo-sensitive devices, every night and all night.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Service is for lighting from Cooperative secondary lines and poles. The Cooperative will own, operate and maintain the lighting fixtures. Burned out lamps must be reported by the member, and the Cooperative will undertake to replace the lamp as soon as possible during regular working hours.

MONTHLY RATE

LAMP RATING	RATE
100 Watts	\$8.25
250 Watts	\$12.50
400 Watts	\$16.00

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

When additional secondary facilities are required, the cost of labor and material for the additional installation will be charged directly to the member and must be paid in advance of construction.

Light shields will be made available for an additional fee.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

This rate schedule is subject to the wholesale power adjustment and will be calculated on the following use:
